ABA/S 1.2.1: Why are Markers helpful and what should be considered?

With Markers an internal connection between Inputs and Outputs can be created. One **Marker Input** has to be assigned to one **Marker Output**. Informations are only exchanged between linked Markers. These connections can be helpful if a large distance has to be bridged on a worksheet or if a connection between two different worksheets must be established.

Notice:

A **Marker Input** can only be assigned to **one** Marker Output.

A **Marker Output** can be assigned to **several** Marker Inputs.
